These are great **basketball** players. ●
On the **left** is LeBron James. He is in his mid-thirties. He is 206 cm tall.
In the **middle** is Stephen Curry. He is in his early thirties. He is 196 cm tall.
On the **right** is Kyle Lowry. He is in his mid-thirties. He is 183 cm tall.

Now, tell me, who is the tallest?
Yes, **LeBron** is the tallest.

Who is the thinnest?
Curry is the thinnest.

Who is the best player?
LeBron, obviously! 🏀

And who is the shortest?
That's right. **Lowry** is the shortest player.

Who is the most expensive player?
LeBron is the most expensive player.

Tallest? Why not taller?

Because we have **more than two people** here. When we have more than two people or things, we say the tallest, the thinnest, or the fastest.

OK, cool. But what is that most?

Well, we don't add **est** to **adjectives** with more than **two** syllables. We put most before the adjective.

The most expensive
The most intelligent

And should we always add that the? 😊
Yep.

the funniest
the craziest
the most difficult

Hold on! Let me give you a real life example!

I am **sleepier** than you, but I'm not the **sleepiest** in our French class. Haha. Jane is the **sleepiest** in the class! She always wants to sleep!

Yes, but you are **the most talkative** student in the French class. You always talk!

Haha. That's true. And you are the **laziest** one!
